

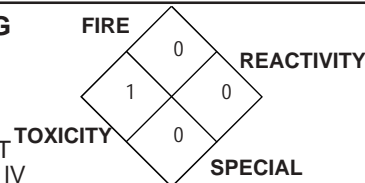



Remove clothing immediately if it is non-impervious clothing that becomes contaminated. The following equipment should be available: Eyewash. Quick drench. It is generally recognized that contact lenses should not be worn when working with chemicals because contact lenses may contribute to the severity of the injury.
